OPDC reveal more detail on delivery plan phases

The Old Oak and Park Royal Development Corporation (OPDC) were exhibiting at MIPIM UK on 18/19 Oct and unveiled new information about their delivery plan.

OPDC CEO Victoria Hills and Commercial Director Simon Wainberg announced that the plan to redevelop the site will come forward in three phases.

The first phase – ‘early activation’ – aims to stimulate confidence that regeneration is coming through a series of small scale initiatives and investments, and will support the delivery of 2,316 homes and 976 jobs.

The second phase – ‘unlocking the North’ – will see the delivery of a further 8,324 homes and 6,549 jobs over the next 20 years supporting significant investment in new roads, rail and social infrastructure.

A final phase – ‘future potential’ phase – will look at how a series of sites HS2 will use during construction of the new rail line can be developed post 2026, delivering a further 2,456 homes and 16,100 jobs.

Christmas staffing support for Park Royal businesses

Syft is an online platform that is seeking to revolutionise flexible staffing. They have launched a Syft for Park Royal scheme in time for the busy Christmas period.

The scheme connects employers to local workers through Syft’s innovative online platform that allow employers to hire rated and vetted workers for their additional staffing needs with speed and full transparency – whilst also giving employers greater choice and control.

Syft is offering Park Royal businesses free access to their platform over

the busy period to identify and recruit candidates from warehouse operatives to pickers and food production operatives.
